Economy class v Premium Economy v Business Class

Is it really worth the extra money?

This is a question we get asked a lot, and the answer varies depending on the airline and the specific class of service. It's a fact that as more people are taking to travelling again, planes are frequently full to capacity, and the demand for Premium Economy and Business class seats has risen exponentially.

Premium Economy has filled the gap between the more expensive Business class seat and the less expensive economy class seat. It doesn't necessarily fall midway in terms of extra amenities offered, but in many cases it provides a greater degree of comfort seating wise, more choice with pre-boarding preferences, and a somewhat enhanced customer experience in terms of overall enjoyment.

Business Class has been forced to up the ante accordingly, to demonstrate value for money with the service and amenities offered against premium Economy. In most cases this has occurred. The seats are wider, have greater extension or fully lay flat. There are fewer seats, greater menu choices, more luggage allowance, priority embarkation and disembarkation, complimentary access to lounges, (some with full bathroom facilities). Many provide bedding for sleep, make up the bed and even provide your own personal pj's at sleeping times. They have bigger screens, more privacy and often a personal mini-bar. There are some who even have a bar at which you can stand and talk to fellow travellers during your flight, and others have showers onboard for guest use.

It's fair to say, we have never received a complaint about the difference in price flying Business Class once the guest has experienced the difference for themselves. The difficulty thereafter is returning to any seat further back in the plane.

So is it worth the difference in price?. It comes down to the individual and their circumstances. Business class is a luxury for sure, but if you can afford it, treat yourself once in a while, you earned it!
